As a corporate body the company is committed to minimising the environmental impact of its activities, processes and systems through improving energy and natural resource conservation, the prevention of pollution, minimising waste, recycling materials, safe and responsible disposal of waste and effluent, and minimising environmentally damaging emissions or pollutants.

There is an ongoing expectation that all employees will accept their legal responsibility to work in a safe manner, adhere to the established safety rules and work procedures, use the safety equipment as provided, and contribute to the maintenance of safe, healthy and environmentally responsible working conditions.
